# a LAVENDER BAG

## Virtual Day Trips

You will need:

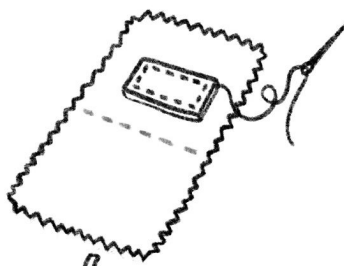
- a piece of Cotton (or Light Fabric) 12" x 4.5"
- Scissors (or Pinking Shears for fabric cutting)
- Green Felt
- a Pretty Button
- 2 Needles (1 x small eyed + 1 x big eyed)
- Thread
- Embroidery Thread
- Dried Lavender
- Ribbon

### STEP ONE



Cut 2 leaves out from the green felt.

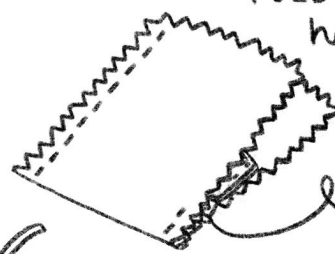
### STEP TWO



Decorate the top half of the cotton with more FABRIC or by SEWING patterns with embroidery thread.

Using PINKING SHEARS stops the fabric from fraying.

### STEP THREE



FOLD the cotton in half with the 'right' sides facing each other, then stitch the sides together.

### STEP FOUR

FILL the bag with the dried lavender until it is HALF filled.



Now - turn it INSIDE OUT so you can SEE your DECORATIONS.

No LAVENDER? Fill with RICE and use a few drops of ESSENTIAL OIL to create the fragrance.

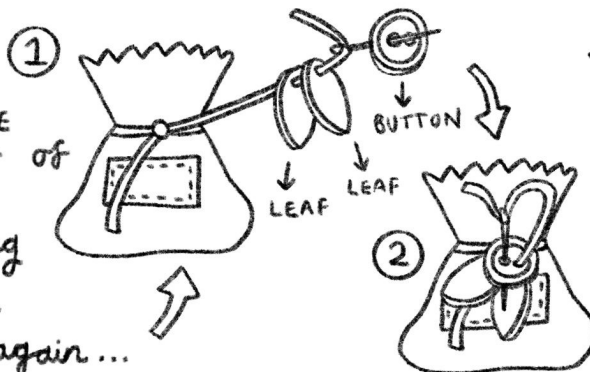
### STEP FIVE

Wrap the ribbon AROUND the bag TWICE, then tie a knot to secure



### STEP SIX

Thread the ribbon onto the BIG EYED NEEDLE then through the corner of the FELT LEAVES. Then add the BUTTON, passing the needle back through so that it meets other strand of the ribbon again...



...Then TIE the ribbon strands together into a bow.
